Item 12 - Arnside Car Parking

Steve Porter was asked to investigate the issue of motorhome parking on the foreshore parking area (20-21/302). SP contacted NCP for advice and met their representative, Bob Young, in May to discuss. SP explained the background and BY agreed to draft a proposal which looked at car parking on the Promenade in general.

BY has produced a draft proposal, of which the salient points are:

- 1. We charge for car parking on the foreshore site and at the southern end of the Promenade.
- 2. Enforcement by ANPR system.
- 3. Parking remains free on Promenade between Silverdale Road and Station Road.
- 4. Resident's parking permits issued.
- 5. Foreshore: an ANPR camera and card-only pay station at entrance.
- 6. South Promenade: ANPR cameras and card-only pay station/s.
- 7. 50p/hr charge.
- 8. 60-40 income split between APC and NCP.
- 9. NCP cover cost of installation and management of infrastructure.
- 10. Projected annual income for APC averages ~£80k over each of next 10 years.

Unresolved issues:

- Ownership/ leasing of foreshore site.
- Local business response.
- Local residents response.

If councillors wish to pursue this, BY has offered to meet the Council to put the case. SP has a presentation from BY which gives much more detail and sets the full case.
