- 5) Anne Kitchen has agreed to act as consultant to the pilot.
- 6) there was a site meeting at Beechwood on 28th June with Helen Chaffey, Dougie Walters and Steve Porter, Chair when we discussed:
 - The current management of the site;
 - The possible future management regimes;
 - a species survey (SP and Anne Kitchen);
- 7) Paul Barnes drafted a slide presentation (as agreed on 23rd June) to explain the purpose and process of pilot (now in 4th draft after consideration by the Working Group).
- 8) The next site visit to Blackdyke Road recycling centre on Tues 6th July at 4:30pm;
- 9) The next meeting of the Working Group will be after that, date to be decided.
